Life Project 4 Youth (LP4Y) has announced its first London edition of the international art initiative Together We Art: Architect of One's Life, an exhibition and auction to benefit the charity's work in supporting excluded young adults living in extreme poverty through entrepreneurship.

Together We Art: Architect of One's Life, opening 15 through to 19 November invites established artists and architects sensitive to Youth empowerment to participate and donate work to be sold during the week-long exhibition at Cromwell Place.

The curated exhibition features the work of more than 23 accomplished multi-disciplinary artists including **Alice Anderson, Nancy Cadogan, Amélie Chabannes, Saraï Delfendahl, Nathalie Du Pasquier, Rayan Elnayal, Birkin Haward, Thomas Heatherwick, Matthew Hilton, Jeremy Hutchison, JonOne, Liane Lang, Nicolas Lefevre, Marie Maillard, Jamie Morgan, Sven Mouton, Michael Pemberton, Jemma Powell, Rails x Mag, Narinder Sagoo MBE, and Emma Summerton.**

LionHeart, the spoken word poet, architect and installation artist, will be in conversation with the Editorial Director of Dezeen **Max Fraser**, Architect **Selasi Setufe MBE** and LP4Y Founder **Laure Delaporte** about the charity's work. Together they will discuss how artists and architects are able to shine a light on how an environment fosters transformation, inclusivity, and encourages communities to explore, engage and connect with each other.

Works will be on display and available to bid through a private auction on 14 November, and then bidding will continue online [here](#).

Together We Art: Architect of One's Life London is the fourth city to launch LP4Y's global initiative with exhibitions also taking place in New York City, Rome and Paris. The initiative aims to collaborate and forge together a community of artists, collectors, visitors, international organisations, entrepreneurs and businesses to showcase artists whose contributions go directly to supporting the work of Life Project 4 Youth (LP4Y).

The exhibition opens 15 through to 19 November at Cromwell Place, London.
